COMPATIBLE WITH ALL MAJOR TRACTOR BRANDS

Our implements undergo considerable testing to be compatible with all major tractor brands. If your tractor has a Cat-1 or Cat-2 hitch, a Universal Quick-Attach loader, or one of several compatible John Deere® loaders, our attachments will work for you!

UNDERSTANDING YOUR TRACTOR

Before you buy any attachment, you need to know your tractor's specifications:

1. Horsepower (HP)

Your tractor's horsepower determines the size and power of implements it can handle. Always select attachments designed to work within your tractor's HP range to avoid performance issues or equipment damage

2. Weight and Size

A heavy implement paired with a light tractor can cause instability. Check your tractor's weight and overall size to make sure it can safely operate the attachment you're considering.

3. Lift Capacity

Pay attention to the lift capacity of your tractor's three-point hitch or front loader.

Overloading your machine can reduce performance and cause wear on its components.

PTO COMPATIBILITY



If the implement is powered by the tractor, such as a tiller or mower, you'll need to confirm it matches your tractor's Power Take-Off (PTO) specifications. Key details include:

- •PTO Shaft Size: Most compact and utility tractors use a standard 1 3/8" 6-spline shaft.
- •PTO Speed: Common speeds are 540 RPM or 1000 RPM. Make sure your implement is designed for the correct PTO speed.

Front-End Loader Quick Attach

A front-end loader quick attach system allows tractor owners to effortlessly switch between attachments like pallet forks, grapples, and buckets without tools. Many modern tractors use a universal quick attach system, making it easy to connect and disconnect implements in seconds. For John Deere owners, Homestead Implements offers a Pinnacle Series John Deere® Quick-Attach to Skid Steer Quick-Attach Adapter. This front-end adapter allows John Deere® hook and pin quick-attach loaders to seamlessly connect with Skid Steer Quick-Attach (SSQA) implements, making it compatible with a wide range of SSQA attachments.

Three-Point Quick Hitch

A three-point quick hitch simplifies the process of attaching and detaching rear implements such as box blades, rotary tillers, and landscape rakes. Designed for Category 1 and 2 hitches, these systems reduce the need for manual adjustments, ensuring a secure fit with minimal effort. Homestead Implements provides durable quick hitches to help operators spend less time on setup and more time working. By reducing strain and improving efficiency, a three-point quick hitch makes working with multiple implements much more convenient.

LAND CLEARING & MAINTAINING

A grapple and brush cutter work together to make land clearing and maintenance more efficient. The grapple is perfect for grabbing, lifting, and removing debris like fallen trees, brush piles, and large rocks, making cleanup quick and manageable. Once the heavy debris is cleared, the brush cutter takes over, slicing through thick grass, weeds, saplings, and dense undergrowth to reclaim overgrown areas and maintain pastures, trails, and fields. Together, these attachments streamline tough land management tasks and keep your property in top shape.



GRADING & SITE PREPARATION

Creating a smooth, even surface is key for driveways, construction sites, and landscaping projects. A box blade is perfect for spreading and leveling materials, while back blades offer precise grading control for driveways and roads. Land planes are excellent for maintaining gravel driveways by redistributing material evenly, and a rock bucket makes clearing large rocks and debris effortless. For final touches, a landscape rake helps refine soil surfaces, making it easier to establish a clean and professional looking finish for any project.



SNOW REMOVAL

When winter hits, having the right equipment makes snow removal faster and more efficient. A snow plow attachment clears driveways and roads quickly, pushing heavy snow out of the way with ease. A snow pusher is ideal for moving large amounts of snow without leaving windrows, making it an excellent choice for parking lots or wide-open areas. For those needing a versatile option, a back blade helps manage lighter snowfall and keeps pathways clear throughout the season.



SOIL PREP FOR PLANTING

Prepare your soil for planting with the right tractor attachments. The Rock Bucket effectively clears rocks, stumps, and debris, leaving behind finely sorted soil. The Middle Buster breaks through tough soil and is perfect for single-row planting and harvesting root vegetables. A post hole digger simplifies the process by drilling consistent, properly sized holes in various soil types.
